Councilmember Lipscomb moved that the nominations be closed and that Councilmember Poss be elected mayor pro tem of the city council by acclamation. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Greyson and unanimously adopted.

Councilmember Mary Poss was elected mayor pro tem of the city council by acclamation.
