*The Ad Hoc Canvassing Committee, consisting of myself (Rickey D. Callahan), Mayor Pro Tem Casey Thomas, Deputy Mayor Pro Tem Adam Medrano and Councilmembers: B. Adam McGough and Jennifer S. Gates were appointed May 15, 2019 to canvass the returns of the City Council Runoff Election held Saturday, June 8, 2019, to elect 5 members to the City Council.*
