Councilmember Willis stated the following:

"The Ad Hoc Canvassing Committee, consisting of myself (Gay Donnell Willis), Councilmember Tennell Atkins, Councilmember Casey Thomas, Councilmember Adam McGough, and Councilmember Jaime Resendez was appointed September 14, 2022 to canvass the returns of the City Council Special Election held Tuesday, November 8, 2022, on the question of approving and implementing a proposition designating the expansion of the Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center Dallas (KBHCCD) and certain improvements at Fair Park within the city of Dallas as venue projects and designating the method of financing pursuant to Chapter 334, Texas Local Government Code.

The Ad Hoc Canvassing Committee met earlier today to canvass the results of the Tuesday, November 8, 2022 special election.

On behalf of the Ad Hoc Canvassing Committee, I make the following report, a copy of which has been provided to each of you:

In the Special Election on the question of approving and implementing a resolution designating the expansion of the Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center Dallas and certain improvements at Fair Park within the city of Dallas as venue projects:

Based upon the statement of returns, we find:

Proposition A did receive sufficient votes to be approved by the qualified voters of the City of Dallas participating in the election and can be applied.

These results, as provided by Dallas County and Collin and Denton counties for Council District for the City of Dallas Special Election held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, appear to be accurate and the Ad Hoc Canvassing Committee recommends the City Council adopt the resolution accepting the report.
