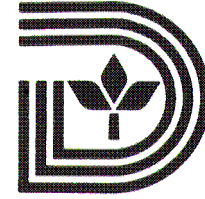

SUBJECT Committee Recommendation on Five-Signature Memorandum

Pursuant to City Council Rules of Procedure Section 6.2(a), Councilmember Bazaldua submitted a five-signature memorandum requesting that the mayor refer the following item to a city council committee:

A resolution amending the city's policy governing the use of legislature travel funds in order to more efficiently allow for councilmembers to travel to Austin and Washington D.C to speak on legislatives matters.

On September 10, 2024, the Ad Hoc Committee on Administrative Affairs (AHCAA) was briefed on the item and, in accordance with City Council Rules of Procedure Section 6.2(h), recommended to the city council that the item as presented be denied (5/0 vote).
