PHOTO ID LAW:

Texas' Voter Photo ID Law, passed as S.B. 14 in 2011, and is now law. Dallas County voters are required to show photo identification when voting in person. For information about photo ID requirements, including exemptions, visit www.VoteTexas.gov or www.DallasCountyVotes.org. For information on how to obtain a free Election Identification Certificate (EIC), visit www.DPS.Texas.gov/DriverLicense/electionID.htm.

EARLY VOTING BY MAIL:

Eligible voters can call the Elections Department at **214.819.6300** or **214.819.6359** for an application for an early ballot by mail or send a letter with the following information:

**Name, Residence Address, Voting Precinct Number, Voter Certificate Number,
Reason for Requesting an Early Ballot, Name of Election and Signature or
Request of Annual Application for a Ballot by Mail and Signature**

An early ballot by mail may be requested if one of the reasons listed below applies:

- a) Age 65 or over as of Election Day;
- b) Confinement in jail;
- c) Absence from county on Election Day and during the entire period of personal appearance early voting;
- d) Disability due to sickness or physical condition.

The applicant must also give the address where they wish their ballot to be mailed, if the address is different from the address where the applicant is registered to vote.

EARLY VOTING BY MAIL - continued:

If the applicant is unable to sign his or her name, they should make a mark and have someone witness their mark. The witness should give their name and address.

The Elections Administrator's office accepts applications for early voting 60 days prior to Election Day. **The last day to accept an Early Voting Application for a Ballot By Mail** for the May 9, 2015 Joint Election for Cities and School Districts is **Thursday, April 30, 2015.**
