DALLAS, TEXAS - The General & Joint Election will take place on Tuesday, November 6, 2018. Candidates, issues, Voter Registration information, Early Voting information, and important voting-related information are contained in this press release.

The Ballot for this election contains options for Straight Party Voting, and for Write-in Candidates. Since this is also a Joint Election, on Election Day many voters may receive two ballots; one with countywide issues and another with city or school (or both) issues.

Dallas County's Voter Registration office will be open on Saturday, October 6, 2018 (weekend before the deadline), from 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM, and on Sunday, October 7, 2018 from 1:00 PM to 6:00 PM. The Voter Registration office will have extended service hours on October 9, 2018; we will be open until 7:00 PM. All applications must be mailed to Dallas County Elections, 2377 N. Stemmons Freeway, Suite 820, Dallas, TX, 75207-2706 and **must be postmarked by Tuesday, October 9, 2018.**

Voter registration application forms are attached in English and Spanish language. Voter Registration Applications have also been supplied to libraries, post offices and county government centers in Dallas County.

Voter registration applications must be submitted by:

1. Mail or personal delivery to 2377 N. Stemmons Freeway, Dallas, Texas 75207; or
2. By telephonic facsimile machine to (214) 819-6307.

For a registration application submitted by telephonic facsimile machine to be effective, a copy of the registration application must be submitted by mail and be received by the registrar not later than the fourth business day after the transmission by telephonic facsimile machine is received.

Voter registration applications can also be dropped off into two application drop boxes located at:

1. Lobby of Dallas County Health & Human Services Bldg., 2377 N. Stemmons Freeway, Dallas, Texas 75207; and,
2. Lobby of George L. Allen Sr. Courts Bldg., 600 Commerce Street, Dallas, Texas 75202.

If you have moved, changed any information important to voter registration, or you are not sure of your registration status, make sure you ask or notify Dallas County Elections Department at (214) 819-6300. To request an Application for Ballot by Mail, eligible voters can send an Application for Ballot by Mail form or an "informal application" by mail (Dallas County Elections Dept., 2377 N. Stemmons Freeway, Suite 820, Dallas, TX 75207), fax to 214.819.6301, or email to EVAPPLICATIONS@DALLASCOUNTY.ORG no later than **Friday, October 26th, 2018**. The request **must be received (not postmarked) by October 26th**. **IMPORTANT NOTE:** If you fax or email your application form, please be aware that you must also mail the form to the Dallas County Elections Department, Attn: Early Voting, 2377 N. Stemmons Freeway, Suite 820, Dallas, TX 75207 within four (4) business days. Application for Ballot by Mail, related instructions and eligibility requirements are on our website at www.dallascountyvotes.org/absentee-voting; or by calling (214) 819-6300.

Texas Election Code §84 now provides that a voter may deliver their carrier envelope containing their marked ballot in person on election day from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. to the early voting clerk at Dallas County Elections. The voter must provide an acceptable form of ID upon delivery of the carrier envelope. Pursuant to Texas Election Code §102.001, voters with the onset of an illness on or after **Thursday, October 25, 2018** (day before the last day to apply for a ballot by mail), may obtain an **Application For Emergency Early Voting Ballot Due To Sickness Or Physical Disability** from the Texas Secretary of State's website at: <http://www.sos.state.tx.us/elections/forms/pol-sub/5-25f.pdf#search=Emergency%20voting>. (For sickness or physical disability originating on or after the day before the last day to submit an application for ballot by mail, preventing the voter from attending the polling place on election day or during early voting.)

Voters who will be absent from their county of residence on election day because of a death that occurred on or after **Thursday, November 1, 2018** (the day before the last day of the period for early voting by personal appearance, may request an **Application for Emergency Ballot Due to Death in Family**, pursuant to Texas Election Code §§103.001, 103.004(b). The application can be obtained from the Texas Secretary of State at: <http://www.sos.state.tx.us/elections/forms/pol-sub/5-24f.pdf>, or from Dallas County Elections Department website <https://www.dallascountyvotes.org/wp-content/uploads/2012/08/EmergencyBallot.pdf>.
