Deputy Mayor Pro Tem McGough stated the following:

*The Ad Hoc Canvassing Committee, consisting of myself (Adam McGough) Councilmember Tennell Atkins, Councilmember Jennifer S. Gates, Councilmember Casey Thomas and Mayor Pro Tem Adam Medrano were appointed May 12, 2021 to canvass the returns of the City Council Runoff Election held Saturday, June 5, 2021, to elect 6 members (that did not receive sufficient votes to be elected at the May 1, 2021 General Election) to the City Council.*

*The Ad Hoc Canvassing Committee met earlier today (June 14, 2021) to canvass the results of the Saturday, June 5, 2021 runoff election.*

*On behalf of the Ad Hoc Canvassing Committee, I make the following report, a copy of which has been provided to each of you.*

*Based upon the statement of returns provided by Dallas County for the City of Dallas Runoff Election held on Saturday, June 5, 2021, we find the following candidates received a majority of the votes cast by the qualified voters of the City of Dallas for the individual city council place indicated:*
