Rules of Courtesy

City Council meetings bring together citizens of many varied interests and ideas. To insure fairness and orderly meetings, the Council has adopted rules of courtesy which apply to all members of the Council, administrative staff, news media, citizens and visitors. These procedures provide:

- That no one shall delay or interrupt the proceedings, or refuse to obey the orders of the presiding officer.
- All persons should refrain from private conversation, eating, drinking and smoking while in the Council Chamber.
- Posters or placards must remain outside the Council Chamber.
- No cellular phones or audible beepers allowed in Council Chamber while City Council is in session.

"Citizens and other visitors attending City Council meetings shall observe the same rules of propriety, decorum and good conduct applicable to members of the City Council. Any person making personal, impertinent, profane or slanderous remarks or who becomes boisterous while addressing the City Council or while attending the City Council meeting shall be removed from the room if the sergeant-at-arms is so directed by the presiding officer, and the person shall be barred from further audience before the City Council during that session of the City Council. If the presiding officer fails to act, any member of the City Council may move to require enforcement of the rules, and the affirmative vote of a majority of the City Council shall require the presiding officer to act." Section 3.3(c) of the City Council Rules of Procedure.

- Ninguna persona retrasará o interrumpirá los procedimientos, o se negará a obedecer las órdenes del oficial que preside la asamblea.
- Todas las personas deben abstenerse de entablar conversaciones, comer, beber y fumar dentro de la cámara del Ayuntamiento.
- Anuncios y pancartas deben permanecer fuera de la cámara del Ayuntamiento.
- No se permite usar teléfonos celulares o enlaces electrónicos (*paggers*) audibles en la cámara del Ayuntamiento durante audiencias del Ayuntamiento Municipal

"Los ciudadanos y visitantes presentes durante las asambleas del Ayuntamiento Municipal deben de obedecer las mismas reglas de comportamiento, decoro y buena conducta que se aplican a los miembros del Ayuntamiento Municipal. Cualquier persona que haga comentarios impertinentes, utilice vocabulario obsceno o difamatorio, o que al dirigirse al Ayuntamiento lo haga en forma escandalosa, o si causa disturbio durante la asamblea del Ayuntamiento Municipal, será expulsada de la cámara si el oficial que este presidiendo la asamblea así lo ordena. Además, se le prohibirá continuar participando en la audiencia ante el Ayuntamiento Municipal. Si el oficial que preside la asamblea no toma acción, cualquier otro miembro del Ayuntamiento Municipal puede tomar medidas para hacer cumplir las reglas establecidas, y el voto afirmativo de la mayoría del Ayuntamiento Municipal precisará al oficial que este presidiendo la sesión a tomar acción." Handgun Prohibition Notice for Meetings of Governmental Entities

"Pursuant to Section 46.03, Penal Code (places weapons prohibited), a person may not carry a firearm or other weapon into any open meeting on this property."

"De conformidad con la Sección 46.03, Código Penal (coloca armas prohibidas), una persona no puede llevar un arma de fuego u otra arma a ninguna reunión abierta en esta propiedad."

SUBJECT **Judicial Nominating Commission Recommendation to Consider a 3% Increase for Municipal Judges**

In Section 13-5.2(a)(3) of the Dallas City Code provides that the Judicial Nominating Commissions (JNC) shall review and make a recommendation to the City Council Ad Hoc Nominations Committee on the salary structure for Municipal Judges.

On May 16, 2024, the Judicial Nomination Commission (JNC) met to discuss the 3% increase and appointment process of the Municipal judges based on previous practice in preparation for the Municipal judge term that ends on May 31, 2024.

The Judicial Nomination Commission (JNC) made a motion to recommend a 3% increase for the Administrative Judge, Municipal Judges, and Associate Judges effective on the beginning of the first pay period after Council's approval. The following analysis and recommendation based on market data is listed below and if approved the new amount will be programed in the FY2024-2025 reported budget.

- Associate Judges are going from \$66.10 to \$68.08 (3%)
- Municipal Judges are going from \$140,000 to \$144,200 (3%)
- Administrative Judge is going from \$155,00 to \$159,650 (3%)

As you may be aware, the full-time Municipal Judges, including the Administrative Judge and Associate Judges, are appointed every two years through a Judicial recruiting process that is conducted by the Judicial Nominating Commission (JNC). The process includes reviewing court operations, accepting applications, conducting interviews, and recommending judges to the City Council Ad Hoc Judicial Nominating Committee.

Recently, the Judicial Nominating Commission (JNC) initiated a review of applicants to appoint judges upon the expiration of the current term. The job position announcements were posted on March 1, 2024, through April 5, 2024, and candidate interviews were held on the following dates:

- April 25, 2024
- April 30, 2024
- May 13, 2024

The JNC, as required by City Ordinance and pursuant to proper notice, convened into executive session and interviewed candidates for the full-time Municipal Judges including the Administrative Judge and Associate Judge positions of the City of Dallas. For your reference, attached you will find a copy of the total list of interviewed candidates and the Judicial Positions Recruitment Process.

Based on interviews, evaluations, and deliberations the JNC has ranked in order of preference and recommends to the Ad Hoc Judicial Nominating Committee **(3)** three candidates for Administrative Judge, **(15)** fifteen candidates for full-time Municipal Judge, and **(23)** twenty-four candidates for Associate Judge.
