In accordance with the provisions of Section 51A-9.30(b) of the Dallas Development Code, please proceed with the process for the consideration of a Street Name Change of Pennsylvania Avenue, from Robert B. Cullum Boulevard to Washington Street.

Richard Knight Jr. was the first Black City Manager of Dallas. His leadership extended far beyond city management, making significant contributions to the city's growth and development. He served as Chairman of the Board for the State Fair of Texas at Fair Park for four years, demonstrating his commitment to community service and civic engagement. With a distinguished career spanning over thirty-five years, he played an instrumental role in shaping the city's progress. Renaming Pennsylvania Avenue in his honor would be a fitting tribute to his exceptional leadership, pioneering accomplishments, and lasting legacy in Dallas.
